BIZZY BEES

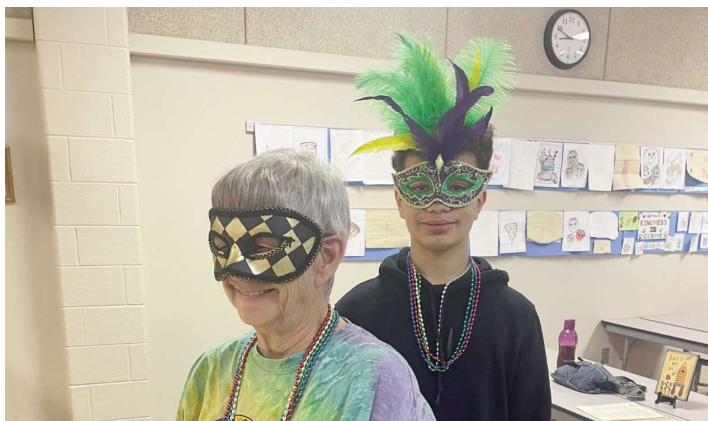
