75th NSDC plans being finalized for Diamond Jubilee



The 75th National Square Dance Convention® team under the leadership of General Chairman Gary and Claudia Lester is working diligently to bring you the best National Convention to be held June 24-27, 2026 in Waco, Texas. This year marks a celebration of 75 years of conventions with the NSDC's Diamond Jubilee, which will be recognized and celebrated throughout major convention events. The year 2026 also marks the 250th birthday of the United States of America to be distinguished with a special event Friday night during the convention, so make sure to wear your red, white and blue. While some details, times and locations are still being finalized, there's plenty of general information about the 75th NSDC and its venue, the Waco Convention Center, available on the official convention website, *National Squares* E-Magazine, and Facebook.

All dance events will be held in the Waco Convention Center, located at 100 Washington Ave. in Waco, Texas. Due to the growing size of the convention, the education classes, Sew & Save clinics will be held in the attached Hilton Waco Hotel. Earlier that week Roundalab will be conducting their 45th Annual Convention in the Hilton Waco Hotel. The NCOS training will be conducted in the adjacent Courtyard by Marriott, and the USDA Board meeting will be held in McLennan Hall #3 on Wednesday from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. If you've not yet registered for the 75th NSDC's Diamond Jubilee, go to <https://75nsdctx.com/long-form-registration/>. Take time to explore the convention website at <https://75nsdctx.com> where you can find information on guided and self-guided tours of the Waco area, vendor information, campground and hotel details, points of interest and more. Please be aware Arlington/Dallas and Houston are hosting matches for the FIFA Soccer World Cup in June, so book your airline tickets and car rental for the 75th NSDC as early as possible for the best prices.

Grand Square International with the National Square Dance Convention® will conduct the annual GSI/NSDC Callers School at the Hilton Waco Hotel on Sunday then switch to the lower level of the Waco Convention Center for sessions on Monday-Wednesday. The Courtyard by Marriott is the official dance leader hotel for the 75th NSDC. The GSI/NSDC Callers School is free to registered guests at the Waco convention. To register for the school, go to www.gscallerschool.com or email Tony Oxendine at Tony@TonyOxendine.com, space is limited and is almost full.

If you are looking to expand your knowledge and/or dancing skills, the 75th NSDC promises plenty of dance workshops and education workshops, including several never-before-offered classes and topics. Make sure to attend the Keynote Address featuring Ted Lizotte, Chairman of the Board for CALLERLAB, as he discusses implementation of the simplified Transitionary Implementation Phase of the Program Policy (TIPPP) that develops a streamlined path forward for modern square dancing. He details what it means for both dancers and dance leaders. The Roundtable Discussion, immediately following the Keynote Address, will be led by both Ted Lizotte and Teresa Berger, Executive Director of CALLERLAB, and brings together callers and leaders who are putting the TIPPP Framework into action. Panelists include Jeremy Butler, Mike Seastrom, and Shawn Brown.

Featured opening entertainment at the 75th NSDC includes the traditional country music duo The Malpass Brothers on Wednesday afternoon from 4:30-6:30 p.m. General tickets are \$45 and include dinner, which will be served starting at 4 p.m. Dinner options are barbeque beef or grilled chicken. As of early February, The Malpass Brothers show is now sold out. Other exciting events include an explosive opening ceremony, colorful Parade of States and the Sights and Sounds of Texas fashion show, which is billed as a "not your mamma's" fashion event you don't want to miss.

Immediately following are a few key event dates that might help you with planning until the final schedule and Convention Mobile App are released. Please note there are additional activities for solo and youth dancers but information has not yet been revealed. Event times are subject to change. Consult the Mobile App, once

available, for the latest information. The Mobile App will be the most up-to-date source of information and will be provided free to all registered dancers at Waco. A free class will be held early during the convention to show dancers who need assistance on how to use the App. A general information booth will also be available during convention hours.

Planning Tips for The 76TH NSDC



1. Getting Registered

- **Don't wait!** Visit www.76nsdc.com now. You'll get a registration number from the system. Keep your registration number handy; you'll need it often.



2. Booking Your Trip to Colorado

- Denver International Airport (DEN) serves 27 carriers with nonstop service to 230 destinations throughout the Americas, Europe, and Asia.
- Frontier, Southwest, and United all have hubs at DEN.
- Colorado is near the center of the US, so driving here is a viable option.



3. Reserving Your Stay in Northern Colorado

- 76 NSDC has contracted with 17+ quality hotels in Northern Colorado (12 mi. or less from the Convention Center). Prices range from \$109 to \$239 per night.
- Links for booking hotels will be sent to all registrants starting in July 2026, prioritized in the order the long forms are received. Booking your hotel stay with this system is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!** Rooms will be scarce at this time in 2027. There's a national horse show in town during our convention and a national high school girls' softball tournament immediately following it.
- 76 NSDC has vetted 6 campgrounds around the convention center. Prices, discounts, commute time, and other important factors vary greatly, so **go to the website** for important detailed information and links to register (www.76nsdc.com/accommodations/). Links for reserving campsites are available NOW. The best sites will go quickly, so snag your site soon!



4. Motoring Up to Loveland

- Reaching Northern Colorado by car (rental or personal) is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!** This is the West; you need your own "horse" 😊 .
- Airport Shuttles from DEN to FNL (Loveland/Ft. Collins airport) are Landline and Groome (see **Transportation** tab at www.76nsdc.com).



5. Getting To and From the Convention Center

- Primary modes of transportation in Loveland/Ft. Collins are Lyft, Uber, Ztrip (taxi), and City of Loveland Transit (very limited).
- Convention-sponsored shuttle buses are possible; costs and schedules are not finalized at this time.



6. Being At The Convention Center

- Ample parking at or adjacent to the Convention Center will be available @ \$15/day with unlimited in/out privileges.
- Lunch and dinner buffets will be available at the Embassy Suites dining room on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday of the Convention. Tickets are available @ 76nsdc.com/register/.
